The team captain must inform his team about the conditions of participation and the content of the disclaimer. The team captain is responsible for compliance with the safety regulations. Participants take part in the event at their own risk. The organiser accepts no liability whatsoever.

Failure to comply with the safety instructions and the conditions of participation may result in the exclusion of individuals or the entire team.

By signing this form, I accept the conditions of participation and rules, the safety regulations and the exclusion of liability on behalf of the team I have registered and undertake to inform all team members fully and comprehensively of these.

Exclusion of liability / Safety instruction:

1. Dragon boat paddling is both a recreational and competitive sport that requires full physical exertion. Every participant must be able to swim 50 metres in light clothing/sportswear and be in good health to take part in this type of sport.
2. Children and young people under the age of 18 require a declaration of consent from a parent or guardian, which must be enclosed with the registration documents. (see page 4)
3. The team captain is responsible for his team, compliance with the race rules and safety regulations. He undertakes to inform all participants in his team about the conditions of participation, the exclusion of liability and the safety instructions.
4. The instructions of the organisers and their representatives (e.g. judges, helmsmen and DLRG) must be followed at all times.
5. Each participant takes part in the event, especially in training and races, at his/her own risk.
6. The organisers, the participating organisations and persons assume no liability. This also applies to the loss and / or damage of items carried and deposited. As no storage facilities can be offered, each team is responsible for the safekeeping of its own valuables.
7. Non-compliance with the conditions of participation, rules, instructions, safety and safety instructions or unsportsmanlike behaviour can lead to the disqualification of individuals and / or the entire team.
8. Participants who are noticeably intoxicated may be banned from starting by the organiser.
9. The organiser is entitled to shorten or cancel the event in cases of force majeure (thunderstorms, storms, floods) and due to special events (war, terror, strikes, official orders, etc.).
10. It is not permitted to erect team tents/pavilions on the event site without prior agreement (size, type of fastening).
